The North Shore HOME Consortium is updating its 5-Year Consolidated Plan for its investment of HOME Investment Partnership Program funds with respect to affordable housing development and homelessness services. The North Shore HOME Consortium is comprised of the following 30 municipalities: Amesbury, Andover, Beverly, Boxford, Danvers, Essex, Georgetown, Gloucester, Hamilton, Haverhill, Ipswich, Lynnfield, Manchester, Marblehead, Merrimac, Methuen, Middleton, Newburyport, North Andover, North Reading, Peabody, Rockport, Rowley, Salem, Salisbury, Swampscott, Topsfield, Wenham, West Newbury, and Wilmington. The City of Peabody is the Consortium's lead community.

As a recipient of HOME funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Consortium is required to update its Consolidated Plan every 5 years. The Consolidated Plan establishes performance goals and funding priorities for the allocation of affordable housing funds over the next five years. In an effort to best understand what issues are most important to residents of the member communities, the Consortium is asking for input about priorities for housing, homelessness, and community development needs. The following survey allows neighborhood residents to add their voice about what community needs are most important to them. The Consortium is eager to hear directly from you and will use this information as it sets priorities around the development of affordable housing and housing related programs. The survey will take approximately 15 minutes to complete and will help inform the development of the strategic plan.


